## Late Fees

- 3.1. A \$25 late fee charge will be applied to all payments made after the 3day grace period. Missed payments will be applied to the next month plus the \$25 late fee. Your tour will be automatically cancelled after two missed payments **NO EXCEPTIONS**.
- There will be no refund of the deposit or any payments that were made for the tour if it was cancelled due to missed payments. Your tour must be paid in full by December 21, 2024. Final payments not received by December 21, 2024, will be charged an additional \$25 for every 3 days payment is not received. If a late final payment is received without the additional late fees included, your tour will be cancelled, and **NO refund** will be given. This is **NON-NEGOTIABLE**.

Once payment is received, you will receive an invoice/Trip Packet no later than 3 days after payment. It is your responsibility to provide an email address for the invoice/documents to be emailed. In addition, you must provide a passport biographical page that shows your legal name at the time of booking.

# 5. Refund /Cancellation Policy

You have 90 days before the scheduled tour (November 21, 2024) to cancel. If you cancel your tour after November 21, 2024, there is no refund of any payments. No Exceptions. If you cancel your tour before November 21, 2024, you will receive 25% of your payments made to date, not including your deposit and any additional fees charge by the airline for the 4 international tickets. You can opt to transfer your funds paid on the tour to date (deposit is not included or Airline fees) to a future Globetrotting Sistars LLC tour that you are NOT currently making payments on or receive a refund of your funds paid on the tour to date (deposit/airline fees is not included) within 21 business days. # 5.1 Covid-19 Cancellation Policy/Civil Unrest/Terrorism/War

If Globetrotting Sistars, LLC or its vendors cancel the tour at any time because of terrorism, war, civil unrest, or border closures due to Covid-19 or any other outbreak the tour will be rescheduled for a later date within 12-24 months of cancellation. If we're still unable to reschedule within 12-24 months due to circumstances beyond our control, then a company credit will be issued minus deposit/airline ticket/ cancellation fees. No refunds, only company credit will be issued, **NO EXCEPTION!**

- ★ Etiquette:

Remember ladies, you will be visiting countries whose customs may differ from what you are used to in your home country. Please be aware of the following while we are in Mozambique, Eswatini, Zambia, Zimbabwe & Botswana.

# Please be aware of the following while we are in Mozambique, Eswatini, Zambia, Zimbabwe & Botswana:

Tipping: Tips are customary for performances and entertainment in Mozambique, Eswatini, Zambia, Zimbabwe & Botswana so please make sure you set aside funds for this, especially if you want to take individual or group pictures with performers. It will reflect badly upon yourself and the group if you attempt to sneak in photos or take pictures without tips/donations. Remember this is their livelihood and they rely heavily on our tips/donations to support themselves and their families.

Tips are customary for guides, hotel staff (housekeeping/maids) and restaurant servers. Be prepared to leave a tip when receiving a service in either Zambia, Zimbabwe or Botswana. While it's not mandatory, generally a tip is expected and always appreciated. Please avoid being overly generous, as this may appear that you are flaunting money, but do leave enough to show appreciation for the services you receive. Housekeeping/Hotel Service: \$2-\$3 per night, and up to \$5 in high-end hotels. You can leave the tip on your pillow or in a place where it will be easily located. Tips are recommended to be left per night as the housekeeping staff will not be the same person for each night of your stay.

- ★ Bus Tours: (several hours or less), tip your guide 10% 20% of the cost of the tour. For driver/tour guide for one week the suggested amount is \$4-\$5 per day per passenger. You can give the tip at the end of the week to the driver in an envelope. The preference is for the tip to be given individually rather than as a group. While tips are not mandatory, they are greatly appreciated for all the work that goes into their job catering to travelers.
- ★ Bargaining: Except for goods in supermarkets, high-end shops, hotels and restaurants, nothing in Mozambique, Eswatini, Zambia, Zimbabwe or Botswana has a setprice, so bargaining is expected. The seller may offer the item at 30% 50% more than what they expect for it, so your counteroffer should be lower than what you are expecting to pay. You and the seller will go back and forth until an agreement is made. If you can't come to an agreement, don't get frustrated. Move on and find another vendor and you may even get the price you are looking for once you've walked away. Remember to keep it fun and light.
- ★ Bartering with the locals for items can be fun and can be done in small villages and markets. Feel free to bring items from home that you are willing to trade for items in either Zambia, Zimbabwe or Botswana. Please <u>DO NOT</u> bring junk/cheap items that have no usefulness. Clothing with logos (T-shirts, caps, etc.) are especially interesting to locals.
  - ★ Activities unless stated are not optional. If you choose to opt out of a scheduled activity Globetrotting Sistars LLC will notbe responsible for creating an alternate itinerary. Any excursions or activities that you choose to participate in outside of the designated tour itinerary are at your own discretion. ## When In Mozambique, Eswatini, Zambia, Zimbabwe & Botswana

★ Remember and respect that Mozambique, Eswatini, Zambia, Zimbabwe & Botswana are conservative societies. Don't walk around the towns and villages dressed in bikinis, miniskirts or similar clothing. Women should wear dresses or skirts that reach below the knee. Although alcohol is freely available, drunken behavior is considered offensive. Ask for permission before taking pictures of people or private houses.

# Flight Information

Flights are booked separately! You will depart from your respective cites. Persons can choose the recommended direct flight (14hrs 35min duration) via United Airlines (Flight# UA 188) departing Newark (EWR) at 9:00pm on February 17<sup>th</sup> and arriving in Johannesburg (JNB) O.R. Tambo International Airport at 6:35pm on February 18, 2025. This will ensure that you get some rest and have sufficient time to catch your flight to Mozambique on February 19<sup>th</sup>. However, this will mean you would have to arrange to spend 1 night in Johannesburg South Africa. We would arrange for the extra night and transfer which would be an additional cost. However, people can choose any airline or flight suffice they arrive on time to catch the flight to Mozambique.

**COUNTRIES:** Mozambique (Maputo) – Eswatini (Lobamba) – Zambia (Livingstone) – Zimbabwe (Victoria Falls) - Botswana (Chobe National Park).

- 1. Flight from Johannesburg, South Africa to Maputo, Mozambique 2 x Nights at Maputo AFEC Gloria Hotel. (Wed 19 Fri 21).
- 2. Drive from Maputo to Lobamba, Eswatini. 2 x Nights at Ezulwini Hotel. (Happy Valley Hotel). (Fri 21 Sun 23).
- 3. Flight from Manzini, Eswatini (7:25Hrs) to Johannesburg, South Africa (8:15Hrs) O.R. Tambo Airport. (Sun 23).
- 4. Flight from Johannesburg (11:45Hrs) O. R. Tambo to Victoria Falls (13:20Hrs), Zimbabwe Airport. (Sun 23 Tues 25).
- 5. Transfer directly to Livingstone, Zambia 2 x nights at the Protea Marriott Hotel Livingstone, Zambia.
- 6. Drive to Victoria Falls, Zimbabwe from Livingstone, Zambia 2 x Nights at Azambezi River Lodge. (Tues 25 Fri 28).
- 7. Drive to Chobe National Park Botswana from Victoria Falls. Day trip from Victoria Falls Hotel. (Wednesday 26).
- 8. Check out of Victoria Falls Hotel & check in at international airport or flight to Johannesburg. (Fri 28).

Visas are required and are upon arrival for US citizens.

## Botswana

US citizens are permitted stays up to 90 days total within a 12-month period without a Visa.
